Portfolio Project #1: “Home Media Server”

I have a home server that is running on my network, which allows me to interact with various media libraries on the server whilst I'm at home. Allowed me to get a deeper understanding of how docker containers work, and the problems it solves whilst developing a project.

Portfolio Project #2: “Company Directory”

A mock database gui for looking through your 'company' employees. Features a php backend that will make calls to the mysql database via events on the html dom, via jquery ajax.

Portfolio Project #3: “Gazetteer”

This project was built with a mobile first approach with that also uses a PHP backend to fetch data from third-party APIs (Geonames, OpenWeather etc) based on events on the dom. Plots lots of places of interest in the current country the user is in using leaflet.js, and then data in another country that the user can choose.
